8	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
9	hereby enacts as follows:
10	Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
11	as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a
12	section to read:
13	Section 1617. Filing of Free Application for Federal Student <
14	Aid as Graduation Requirement. Beginning with the 2024 2025
15	school year, in addition to any other requirement under law as a
16	prerequisite to receiving a high school diploma from a public
17	high school, the parent or guardian of each student or, if a
18	student is at least 18 years of age or legally emancipated, the
19	student must comply with either of the following:
20	(1) File a Free Application for Federal Student Aid with the

1 United States Department of Education. 2 (2) On a form developed by the Department of Education, in 3 consultation with the Pennsylvania Higher Education Assistance 4 Agency, sign and file with the student's school district a 5 atement that the parent, quardian or student, as applicable, understands the purpose of the Free Application for Federal_ 6 7 Student Aid or has chosen not to file the application. 8 SECTION 1617. FREE APPLICATION FOR FEDERAL STUDENT AID.--(A) <--9 BEGINNING WITH THE 2024-2025 SCHOOL YEAR, PRIOR TO COMPLETING 10 HIGH SCHOOL, A STUDENT WHO ATTENDS A SCHOOL ENTITY IN THIS COMMONWEALTH, UNLESS EXEMPTED UNDER SUBSECTION (E), SHALL FILE A 11 FAFSA WITH THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION OR SUBMIT 12 13 AN OPT-OUT FORM IN ACCORDANCE WITH SUBSECTION (B). 14 (B) THE PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN OF A STUDENT OR, IF A 15 STUDENT IS AT LEAST EIGHTEEN YEARS OF AGE OR LEGALLY EMANCIPATED, MAY OPT OUT OF FILING THE FAFSA UNDER SUBSECTION 16 17 (A) BY COMPLETING AND SUBMITTING TO THE SCHOOL ENTITY AN OPT-OUT 18 FORM DEVELOPED BY THE DEPARTMENT, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE 19 AGENCY. THE OPT-OUT FORM SHALL INCLUDE A STATEMENT THAT THE 20 PARENT, LEGAL GUARDIAN OR STUDENT, AS APPLICABLE, UNDERSTANDS 21 THE PURPOSE OF THE FAFSA AND HAS CHOSEN NOT TO FILE THE 22 APPLICATION. 23 (C) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL MAKE THE OPT-OUT FORM AVAILABLE TO SCHOOL ENTITIES AND POST THE OPT-OUT FORM ON THE DEPARTMENT'S 24 25 PUBLICLY ACCESSIBLE INTERNET WEBSITE. 26 (D) A SCHOOL ENTITY SHALL PROVIDE A COPY OF THE OPT-OUT FORM 27 TO PARENTS, LEGAL GUARDIANS AND STUDENTS. 28 (E) IF A FAFSA IS NOT FILED OR OPT-OUT FORM IS NOT SUBMITTED 29 ON BEHALF OF A STUDENT, THE SCHOOL ENTITY MAY EXEMPT THE STUDENT FROM THE PROVISIONS OF SUBSECTION (A). PRIOR TO MAKING AN 30

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1	EXEMPTION, THE SCHOOL ENTITY MUST MAKE A REASONABLE EFFORT TO
2	CONTACT THE PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN OF THE STUDENT.
3	(F) THE AGENCY SHALL PROVIDE A SCHOOL ENTITY WITH
4	INFORMATION INDICATING WHETHER A STUDENT OF THE SCHOOL ENTITY
5	HAS COMPLETED THE FAFSA.
6	(G) NOTHING CONTAINED IN THIS SECTION SHALL BE CONSTRUED TO
7	REQUIRE A PARENT, LEGAL GUARDIAN OR STUDENT TO PROVIDE PERSONAL
8	FINANCIAL INFORMATION TO A SCHOOL ENTITY.
9	(H) PERSONAL FINANCIAL INFORMATION INADVERTENTLY OBTAINED
10	FROM A PARENT, LEGAL GUARDIAN OR STUDENT BY A SCHOOL ENTITY AS A
11	RESULT OF ADMINISTERING THIS SECTION IS NOT A PUBLIC RECORD
12	ACCESSIBLE FOR INSPECTION AND DUPLICATION IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE
13	ACT OF FEBRUARY 14, 2008 (P.L.6, NO.3), KNOWN AS THE "RIGHT-TO-
14	KNOW LAW."
15	(I) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, THE FOLLOWING WORDS AND PHRASES
16	SHALL HAVE THE MEANINGS GIVEN TO THEM IN THIS SUBSECTION UNLESS
17	THE CONTEXT CLEARLY INDICATES OTHERWISE:
18	(1) "AGENCY" SHALL MEAN THE PENNSYLVANIA HIGHER EDUCATION
19	ASSISTANCE AGENCY.
20	(2) "DEPARTMENT" SHALL MEAN THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION OF
21	THE COMMONWEALTH.
22	(3) "FAFSA" SHALL MEAN THE FREE APPLICATION FOR FEDERAL
23	STUDENT AID.
24	(4) "SCHOOL ENTITY" SHALL MEAN AN AREA CAREER AND TECHNICAL
25	SCHOOL, CHARTER SCHOOL, CYBER CHARTER SCHOOL, NONPUBLIC SCHOOL,
26	PRIVATE SCHOOL, REGIONAL CHARTER SCHOOL OR SCHOOL DISTRICT.
27	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.

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
