AN ACT

- Designating the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania as a Purple Heart State and August 7 as "Purple Heart Day" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Short title.
- 6 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Purple Heart
- 7 Act.
- 8 Section 2. Legislative findings and declarations.
- 9 The General Assembly finds and declares as follows:
- 10 (1) During major wars from World War I to the present,
- 11 32,080 Pennsylvania veterans were killed in combat and
- approximately 59,140 were wounded, making those
- 13 Pennsylvanians eligible for the Purple Heart Medal.
- 14 (2) The mission of the Military Order of the Purple
- 15 Heart, chartered by an act of Congress, is to foster an
- 16 environment of goodwill among combat wounded veterans and
- their families, to promote patriotism, to support legislative

- 1 initiatives and, most importantly, to ensure that we never
- 2 forget the sacrifices of veterans killed in action and
- 3 wounded in combat.
- 4 (3) Twenty-three states across the United States have
- 5 honored their military veterans wounded and killed in combat
- 6 by proclaiming their states to be Purple Heart states.
- 7 (4) The Purple Heart Trail was established in 1992 by
- 8 the Military Order of the Purple Heart to be a symbolic trail
- 9 throughout all 50 states to commemorate and honor all men and
- 10 women who have been wounded or killed in combat while serving
- in the United States Armed Forces.
- 12 (5) The Purple Heart Trail originates at a monument in
- 13 Mt. Vernon, Virginia, which is the burial location of George
- 14 Washington.
- 15 (6) In Pennsylvania, State Route 45, also known as the
- Purple Heart Highway, winds through 100 miles of Huntingdon,
- 17 Centre, Union, Northumberland and Montour Counties and is
- 18 part of the Purple Heart Trail.
- 19 (7) State Route 45 was christened the Purple Heart
- Highway because the Route 45 corridor has been home to many
- 21 recipients of the Purple Heart.
- 22 (8) The Commonwealth of Pennsylvania honors the service
- and sacrifices of our nation's men and women in uniform
- 24 wounded or killed by the enemy while serving to protect the
- 25 freedom enjoyed by all Americans.
- 26 Section 3. Purple Heart State.
- 27 The Commonwealth is designated as a Purple Heart State.
- 28 Section 4. Purple Heart Day.
- 29 August 7 of each year is designated as "Purple Heart Day."
- 30 Section 5. Effective date.

1 This act shall take effect immediately.
