- 1 Amending Title 51 (Military Affairs) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, in National Guard Youth Challenge
- Program, further providing for administration, for report and
- 4 for audit required.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Sections 9806, 9810 introductory paragraph and
- 8 9811 of Title 51 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are
- 9 amended to read:
- 10 § 9806. Administration.
- 11 (a) Staffing. -- Subject to 32 U.S.C. § 509 (relating to
- 12 National Guard Youth Challenge Program of opportunities for
- 13 civilian youth) and its implementing regulations and applicable
- 14 agreements, the program shall be staffed by the administrative,
- 15 professional, technical and clerical employees necessary for the
- 16 operation of the program.
- 17 (b) Rules and regulations.--The department may adopt and
- 18 promulgate rules and regulations necessary to implement the

- 1 provisions of this chapter.
- 2 § 9810. Report.
- 3 [The department shall submit annually to] By September 30,
- 4 2023, and each September 30 thereafter, the department shall
- 5 <u>submit to the chairperson and minority chairperson of the</u>
- 6 Appropriations Committee of the Senate, the chairperson and
- 7 minority chairperson of the Education Committee of the Senate,
- 8 the chairperson and minority chairperson of the Veterans Affairs
- 9 and Emergency Preparedness Committee of the Senate, the
- 10 chairperson and minority chairperson of the Appropriations
- 11 <u>Committee of the House of Representatives</u>, the chairperson and
- 12 minority chairperson of the Education Committee of the House of
- 13 Representatives and the chairperson and minority chairperson of
- 14 the Veterans Affairs and Emergency Preparedness Committee of the
- 15 House of Representatives a written report concerning the
- 16 program. The report shall include, but not be limited to, all of
- 17 the following:

- 19 § 9811. Audit required.
- The department shall undergo an annual audit of the program.
- 21 The audit shall be conducted in accordance with 31 U.S.C. Ch. 75
- 22 <u>(relating to requirements for single audits)</u> by a qualified
- 23 [independent] certified public accountant under generally
- 24 accepted audit standards of the Governmental Accounting
- 25 Standards Board. The audit shall be submitted to the following:
- 26 (1) The chairperson and minority chairperson of the
- [Education] <u>Appropriations</u> Committee of the Senate.
- 28 (1.1) The chairperson and minority chairperson of the
- 29 Education Committee of the Senate.
- 30 (2) The chairperson and minority chairperson of the

- 1 Veterans Affairs and Emergency Preparedness Committee of the 2 Senate.
- 3 (2.1) The chairperson and minority chairperson of the
 4 Appropriations Committee of the House of Representatives.
 - (3) The chairperson and minority chairperson of the Education Committee of the House of Representatives.
- 7 (4) The chairperson and minority chairperson of the 8 Veterans Affairs and Emergency Preparedness Committee of the 9 House of Representatives.
- 10 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

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
