## AN ACT

- 1 Providing for civil immunity for persons that operate
- agritourism activities under certain circumstances.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Short title.
- 6 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Agritourism
- 7 Activity Civil Immunity Act.
- 8 Section 2. Definitions.
- 9 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 10 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 11 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 12 "Agritourism activity." Activity carried out on a farm that <--
- 13 provides entertainment or education to the general public for
- 14 the purpose of promoting agricultural products or farming or
- 15 rural lifestyles, regardless of whether or not the general
- 16 public pays to participate in the activity including:
- 17 (1) interaction with farm or rural animals;

- 1 (2) farming or harvesting activities;
- 2 (3) tours, exhibitions or taste tests that promote the
- 3 farm or on-farm produced products;
- 4 (4) bed and breakfast operations or similar lodging-
- 5 accommodations that encourage engagement with farming or
- 6 harvesting activities or the farm's agricultural character or
- 7 aesthetic nature;
- 8 (5) equine training, teaching or recreational riding;
- 9 (6) games, rides and other entertainment activities
- 10 normally engaged in by farm families or rural communities;
- 11 and
- 12 (7) activities carried out in conjunction with seasonal
- 13 <u>festivals to promote local agricultural products.</u>
- 14 The term does not include rodeos, hunting, water skiing or
- 15 tubing, paintball and nonmotorized freestyle, mountain or off-
- 16 road bicycling.
- 17 "AGRITOURISM ACTIVITY." FARM-RELATED TOURISM OR FARM-RELATED <--
- 18 ENTERTAINMENT ACTIVITY THAT:
- 19 (1) TAKES PLACE ON A FARM WHERE AGRICULTURAL,
- 20 HORTICULTURAL OR SILVICULTURAL CROPS ARE GROWN OR FARM
- 21 ANIMALS OR FARMED FISH ARE RAISED; AND
- 22 (2) ALLOWS MEMBERS OF THE GENERAL PUBLIC, WHETHER OR NOT
- 23 FOR A FEE, TO TOUR, EXPLORE, OBSERVE, LEARN ABOUT,
- 24 PARTICIPATE IN OR BE ENTERTAINED BY AN ASPECT OF AGRICULTURAL
- 25 PRODUCTION, HARVESTING, HUSBANDRY OR RURAL LIFESTYLE THAT
- 26 OCCURS ON THE FARM.
- 27 "AGRITOURISM PROVIDER." A PERSON WHO OWNS, OPERATES,
- 28 PROVIDES OR SPONSORS AN AGRITOURISM ACTIVITY OR AN EMPLOYEE OF
- 29 SUCH A PERSON WHO ENGAGES IN OR PROVIDES AGRITOURISM WHETHER OR
- 30 NOT FOR A FEE.

- 1 "Anticipated annual gross income." Gross income normally
  2 expected to be generated in one year, without occurrence of a
- 3 natural disaster or other occurrence or condition beyond the

- 4 operator's AGRITOURISM PROVIDER'S reasonable control.
- 5 "Farm." An operation commercially engaged in agriculture
- 6 that:
- 7 (1) is 10 or more acres in contiguous area; or
- 8 (2) has an anticipated annual gross income of at least
- 9 \$2,000 from agricultural production.
- 10 "Operator." A person that engages in an agritourism
- 11 activity.
- 12 Section 3. Immunity.
- 13 (a) Scope. -- Immunity under this section applies to a person-
- 14 if the following apply:
- 15 (1) The person is an operator of an agritourism
- 16 activity.
- 17 (2) The following notice is conspicuously posted in at-
- 18 least two locations on the premises where the agritourism
- 19 activity takes place on a sign at least three feet by two-
- 20 <del>feet:</del>
- 21 You assume the risk of agritourism activities under-
- 22 <del>Pennsylvania law.</del>
- 23 (b) Grant.—A person that meets the requirements of
- 24 subsection (a) shall be immune from liability in a negligence
- 25 action for personal injury or death to another person that-
- 26 voluntarily and intelligently participates in the agritourism
- 27 activity and is injured or killed as a result of that-
- 28 participation.
- 29 "RISK INHERENT IN THE AGRITOURISM ACTIVITY." A DANGER OR
- 30 CONDITION THAT IS AN INTEGRAL PART OF AN AGRITOURISM ACTIVITY,

- 1 INCLUDING ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 2 (1) SURFACE AND SUBSURFACE CONDITIONS OF LAND AND THE
- 3 NATURAL CONDITION OF VEGETATION AND WATER ON THE PROPERTY.
- 4 (2) THE BEHAVIOR OR ACTIONS OF WILD ANIMALS NOT KEPT BY
- 5 OR UNDER THE CONTROL OF AN AGRITOURISM PROVIDER.
- 6 (3) THE ORDINARY DANGERS ASSOCIATED WITH STRUCTURES OR
- 7 EQUIPMENT ORDINARILY USED IN FARMING OR RANCHING OPERATIONS.
- 8 (4) THE POSSIBILITY OF BEING INJURED OR CONTRACTING
- 9 ILLNESS AS A RESULT OF PHYSICAL CONTACT WITH ANIMALS, ANIMAL
- 10 FEED, ANIMAL WASTE OR SURFACES CONTAMINATED BY ANIMAL WASTE.
- 11 (5) THE POSSIBILITY THAT A PARTICIPANT IN THE
- 12 AGRITOURISM ACTIVITY MAY ACT IN A NEGLIGENT MANNER, INCLUDING
- 13 BY FAILING TO FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS GIVEN BY AN AGRITOURISM
- 14 PROVIDER OR BY FAILING TO EXERCISE REASONABLE CAUTION WHILE
- 15 ENGAGING IN THE AGRITOURISM ACTIVITY THAT MAY CONTRIBUTE TO
- 16 INJURY TO THE PARTICIPANT OR ANOTHER PARTICIPANT.
- 17 SECTION 3. IMMUNITY FROM LIABILITY.
- 18 (A) AGRITOURISM PROVIDERS.--
- 19 (1) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (C), IN A
- 20 CIVIL ACTION, AN AGRITOURISM PROVIDER SHALL BE IMMUNE FROM
- 21 LIABILITY FOR ANY HARM A PARTICIPANT SUSTAINS DURING AN
- 22 AGRITOURISM ACTIVITY IF THE PARTICIPANT IS HARMED AS A RESULT
- 23 OF A RISK INHERENT IN THE AGRITOURISM ACTIVITY.
- 24 (2) NOTHING IN THIS SECTION SHALL BE CONSTRUED TO
- 25 REQUIRE AN AGRITOURISM PROVIDER TO ELIMINATE RISKS INHERENT
- 26 IN AGRITOURISM ACTIVITIES.
- 27 (B) NOTICES TO BE POSTED.--
- 28 (1) AN AGRITOURISM PROVIDER SHALL POST AND MAINTAIN
- 29 SIGNS THAT CONTAIN THE WARNING NOTICE SPECIFIED IN THIS
- 30 SECTION AND SHALL PLACE A SIGN IN A CLEARLY VISIBLE LOCATION

- 1 AT OR NEAR EACH ENTRANCE TO THE AGRITOURISM LOCATION OR AT
- 2 THE SITE OF EACH AGRITOURISM ACTIVITY.
- 3 (2) THE WARNING NOTICE SHALL CONSIST OF A SIGN IN BLACK
- 4 LETTERS WITH EACH LETTER TO BE A MINIMUM OF ONE INCH IN
- 5 HEIGHT AND SHALL CONTAIN THE FOLLOWING NOTICE OF WARNING:
- 6 "WARNING: UNDER PENNSYLVANIA LAW, THERE IS NO LIABILITY
- 7 FOR AN INJURY TO OR DEATH OF A PARTICIPANT IN AN
- 8 AGRITOURISM ACTIVITY CONDUCTED AT THIS AGRITOURISM
- 9 LOCATION IF THE INJURY OR DEATH RESULTS FROM THE INHERENT
- 10 RISKS OF THE AGRITOURISM ACTIVITY. INHERENT RISKS OF THE
- 11 AGRITOURISM ACTIVITIES INCLUDE, BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO,
- 12 RISK OF INJURY INHERENT TO LAND, EQUIPMENT AND ANIMALS AS
- 13 WELL AS THE POTENTIAL FOR YOU AS A PARTICIPANT TO ACT IN
- 14 A NEGLIGENT MANNER THAT MAY CONTRIBUTE TO YOUR INJURY OR
- DEATH. YOU ARE ASSUMING THE RISK OF PARTICIPATING IN THIS
- 16 AGRITOURISM ACTIVITY."
- 17 (C) EXCEPTIONS. -- AN AGRITOURISM PROVIDER SHALL NOT BE IMMUNE
- 18 FROM CIVIL LIABILITY FOR HARM SUSTAINED BY A PARTICIPANT IF ANY
- 19 OF THE FOLLOWING APPLIES:
- 20 (1) THE AGRITOURISM PROVIDER ACTS WITH A WILLFUL OR
- 21 WANTON DISREGARD FOR THE SAFETY OF THE PARTICIPANT AND
- 22 PROXIMATELY CAUSES HARM TO THE PARTICIPANT.
- 23 (2) THE AGRITOURISM PROVIDER PURPOSEFULLY CAUSES HARM TO
- THE PARTICIPANTS.
- 25 (3) THE AGRITOURISM PROVIDER'S ACTIONS OR INACTIONS
- 26 CONSTITUTE CRIMINAL CONDUCT AND CAUSE HARM TO THE
- 27 PARTICIPANT.
- 28 (4) THE AGRITOURISM PROVIDER FAILS TO POST AND MAINTAIN
- 29 SIGNS AS REQUIRED BY SUBSECTION (B).
- 30 (5) THE AGRITOURISM PROVIDER HAS ACTUAL KNOWLEDGE OR

- 1 SHOULD HAVE ACTUAL KNOWLEDGE OF AN EXISTING DANGEROUS
- 2 CONDITION ON THE LAND OR REGARDING FACILITIES OR EQUIPMENT ON
- 3 THE LAND THAT IS NOT AN INHERENT RISK AND DOES NOT MAKE THE
- 4 DANGEROUS CONDITION KNOWN TO THE PARTICIPANT AND THE
- 5 DANGEROUS CONDITION PROXIMATELY CAUSES INJURY TO OR DEATH OF
- 6 THE PARTICIPANT.
- 7 Section 4. Applicability.
- 8 This act shall apply to any cause of action that arises on or
- 9 after the effective date of this section.
- 10 Section 5. Effective date.
- 11 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
