16	Section 1. * * *
17	(d) In addition to any other powers and duties imposed by
18	this section, [the Governor shall permit the display of the
19	official POW/MIA flag from the flagpoles of any public building
20	or ground in this Commonwealth.] when the United States flag is

- 1 <u>displayed on any ground or building owned or under the control</u>
- 2 of the Commonwealth, the official POW/MIA flag shall also be
- 3 <u>displayed where it can be reasonably accommodated.</u>
- 4 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
