- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 5551. No limitation applicable.

hereby enacts as follows:

- 9 A prosecution for the following offenses may be commenced at
- 10 any time:

- 11 (1) Murder.
- 12 (2) Voluntary manslaughter.
- 13 (3) Conspiracy to commit murder or solicitation to
- 14 commit murder if a murder results from the conspiracy or
- 15 solicitation.
- 16 (4) Any felony alleged to have been perpetrated in
- 17 connection with a murder of the first or second degree, as
- 18 set forth in 18 Pa.C.S. § 2502(a) or (b) and (d) (relating to

- 1 murder).
- 2 (5) A violation of 75 Pa.C.S. § 3742 (relating to
- 3 accidents involving death or personal injury) [or], 3732
- 4 (relating to homicide by vehicle) or 3735 (relating to
- 5 <u>homicide by vehicle while driving under influence)</u> if the
- 6 accused was the driver of a vehicle involved in an accident
- 7 resulting in the death of any person.
- 8 (6) A violation of 18 Pa.C.S. § 2702(a)(1), (2), (4) or
- 9 (7) (relating to aggravated assault) if the accused knew the
- 10 victim was a law enforcement officer and the law enforcement
- officer was acting within the scope of the officer's duties.
- 12 Section 2. The amendment of 42 Pa.C.S. § 5551(5) shall apply
- 13 to offenses as to which the applicable period of limitations has
- 14 not expired on the effective date of this section.
- 15 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
