## AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An
- act relating to the public school system, including certain
- provisions applicable as well to private and parochial
- schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
- laws relating thereto," in preliminary provisions, further
- 6 providing for Keystone Exams.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. Section 121 of the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30,
- 10 No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, added June 30,
- 11 2012 (P.L.684, No.82), is amended to read:
- 12 Section 121. Keystone Exams. -- [Subject to annual
- 13 appropriation, not later than the 2020-2021 school year, the]
- 14 The Department of Education shall develop and implement Keystone
- 15 Exams only in the following subjects as required by Federal law:
- 16 [algebra I, literature, biology, English composition, algebra
- 17 II, geometry, United States history, chemistry, civics and
- 18 government and world history.]
- 19 (1) Algebra I.

- 1 (2) Literature.
- 2 <u>(3) Biology.</u>
- 3 The State Board of Education shall promulgate regulations,
- 4 subject to the act of June 25, 1982 (P.L.633, No.181), known as
- 5 the "Regulatory Review Act," necessary to implement this
- 6 section.
- 7 Section 2. Any regulation inconsistent with section 121 of
- 8 the act shall be deemed abrogated to the extent of that
- 9 inconsistency.
- 10 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
