12	Section 6. Vaccine-Preventable DiseasesThe following
13	shall apply to consent to receive immunizations:
14	(1) A minor who is fourteen years of age or older may give
15	effective consent to receive a vaccine if the vaccine is
16	recommended by the United States Advisory Committee on
17	Immunization Practices and the vaccine will be provided in
18	accordance with the committee's recommendations for
19	administration of the vaccination.

- 1 (2) The minor's parent's or legal guardian's consent may not
- 2 be necessary to receive a vaccine under paragraph (1).
- 3 (3) A minor who is fourteen years of age or older shall have
- 4 the right to decline a vaccination for which a parent or legal
- 5 guardian has otherwise given consent.
- 6 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
