## AN ACT

Amending Titles 18 (Crimes and Offenses), 23 (Domestic Relations) and 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the 2 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in minors, further 3 providing for the offense of sexual abuse of children; in child protective services, providing for task force on child 5 pornography; and, in sentencing, further providing for sentencing for offenses involving sexual abuse of children. 6 7 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 10 Section 1. Section 6312(d.1) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: 11 12 § 6312. Sexual abuse of children. 13 \* \* \* 14 (d.1) Grading. -- The offenses shall be graded as follows: 15 Except as provided in paragraph (3), an offense 16 under subsection (b) is a felony of the second degree. 17 (2) Except as provided in paragraph (3), a first offense under subsection (c) or (d) is a felony of the 18 third degree. 19 20 (ii) A second or subsequent offense under subsection

- 1 (c) or (d) is a felony of the second degree.
- 2 (3) When a person commits an offense graded under
- 3 paragraph (1) or (2) (i) [and indecent contact with the child
- 4 as defined in section 3101 (relating to definitions) is
- depicted], the grading of the offense shall be one grade
- 6 higher than the grade specified in paragraph (1) or (2)(i)[.]
- 7 <u>if:</u>
- 8 (i) indecent contact with the child as defined in
- 9 section 3101 (relating to definitions) is depicted; or
- 10 (ii) the child depicted is under 10 years of age or
- 11 <u>prepubescent.</u>

- 13 Section 2. Title 23 is amended by adding a section to read:
- 14 § 6388. Task Force on Child Pornography.
- 15 (a) Establishment. -- The Task Force on Child Pornography is
- 16 established.
- 17 (b) Purpose. -- The purpose of the task force is to conduct a
- 18 review to ascertain any inadequacies relating to the offense of
- 19 child pornography in 18 Pa.C.S. § 6312 (relating to sexual abuse
- 20 of children).
- 21 (c) Composition. -- The task force shall consist of the
- 22 following members, who shall be appointed within 25 days after
- 23 the effective date of this section:
- 24 (1) The secretary or a designee.
- 25 (2) The Attorney General or a designee.
- 26 (3) The Commissioner of Pennsylvania State Police or a
- 27 <u>designee</u>.
- 28 (4) The Chairman of the Pennsylvania Commission on Crime
- and Delinguency or a designee.
- 30 (5) The Executive Director of the Pennsylvania

- 1 Commission on Sentencing or a designee. 2 (6) Two members of the Senate, one appointed by the 3 President pro tempore of the Senate and one appointed by the Minority Leader of the Senate. 4 (7) Two members of the House of Representatives, one 5 appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives and 6 7 one appointed by the Minority Leader of the House of 8 Representatives. 9 (8) The Victim Advocate from the Office of Victim 10 Advocate or a designee from that office. 11 (9) The President of the Pennsylvania District Attorneys 12 Association or a designee. 13 (10) The Director of the Pennsylvania Coalition Against 14 Rape or a designee. (11) One member of the Pennsylvania Sexual Offenders 15 Assessment Board. If possible, the member shall be a member 16 of the Association for the Treatment of Sexual Abusers. 17 18 (12) One member of the Pennsylvania Internet Crimes 19 Against Children (ICAC) Task Force. 20 (13) The director of a rape crisis center located in
- 21 <u>this Commonwealth or a designee, appointed by the Governor.</u>
- 22 (14) One representative of a children's advocacy center
  23 that assists in the investigation, prosecution and treatment
  24 of child sexual and physical abuse cases, appointed by the
  25 Governor.
- 26 (15) Two medical professionals that specialize in the
  27 field of child sexual abuse, one of whom shall be appointed
  28 by the President pro tempore of the Senate and one of whom
  29 shall be appointed by the Speaker of the House of
- 30 Representatives.

1	(16) One member of the public, appointed by the
2	President pro tempore of the Senate.
3	(17) One member of the public, appointed by the Speaker
4	of the House of Representatives.
5	(d) Chairperson The Governor shall select the chairperson
6	of the task force.
7	(e) Member requirements
8	(1) The appointed members of the task force under
9	subsection (c)(16) and (17) must be individuals who have
10	experience in investigations or prosecutions of child
11	pornography or sexual abuse of children, have experience in
12	the treatment of victims of child pornography or sexual abuse
13	of children, have experience in the prevention of child
14	pornography or sexual abuse of children or are victims of
15	child pornography or sexual abuse of children.
16	(2) The appointment of members must reflect the
17	geographic diversity of this Commonwealth.
18	(f) Meetings and expenses The task force shall conduct its
19	<pre>business as follows:</pre>
20	(1) The task force shall meet at least four times but
21	may hold additional meetings as determined by the chairperson
22	of the task force.
23	(2) The chairperson of the task force shall schedule a
24	meeting upon written request of eight members of the task
25	force.
26	(3) The first meeting of the task force shall be
27	convened within 45 days of the effective date of this
28	section.
29	(4) The task force shall hold public hearings as
30	necessary to obtain the information required to conduct its

2	(5) Action of the task force shall be authorized or
3	ratified by majority vote of the members of the task force.
4	(6) The Pennsylvania Commission on Crime and Delinquency
5	and the Joint State Government Commission shall cooperate to
6	provide administrative or other assistance to the task force.
7	(7) The members of the task force shall not receive
8	compensation but shall be reimbursed for reasonable and
9	necessary expenses incurred in the service of the task force.
10	(g) Powers The task force shall have the following powers:
11	(1) To recommend any improvements relating to the
12	investigation and prosecution of child pornography as defined
13	<u>in 18 Pa.C.S. § 6312.</u>
14	(2) To recommend any necessary changes in State statutes
15	and practices, policies and procedures relating to the
16	recognition or prosecution of child pornography as defined in
17	18 Pa.C.S. § 6312.
18	(h) Report
19	(1) Within one year of the first meeting of the task
20	force, the task force shall submit a report with its
21	recommendations to the following:
22	(i) The Governor.
23	(ii) The President pro tempore of the Senate.
24	(iii) The Speaker of the House of Representatives.
25	(iv) The chairperson and minority chairperson of the
26	Judiciary Committee of the Senate.
27	(v) The chairperson and minority chairperson of the
28	Judiciary Committee of the House of Representatives.
29	(2) The report under this subsection must be adopted at
30	a public meeting of the task force.

- 1 (3) The report under this subsection shall be a public
- 2 record under the act of February 14, 2008 (P.L.6, No.3),
- 3 known as the Right-to-Know Law.
- 4 (i) Expiration. -- The task force shall expire upon the
- 5 <u>submission of the report under subsection (h).</u>
- 6 (j) Definition. -- As used in this section, the term "task
- 7 <u>force" means the Task Force on Child Pornography established in</u>
- 8 this section.
- 9 Section 3. Section 9720.5 of Title 42 is amended to read:
- 10 § 9720.5. Sentencing for offenses involving sexual abuse of
- 11 children.
- 12 <u>(a) General rule.--</u>The Pennsylvania Commission on
- 13 Sentencing, in accordance with section 2154 (relating to
- 14 adoption of guidelines for sentencing), shall provide for a
- 15 sentence enhancement within its guidelines for an offense under
- 16 18 Pa.C.S. § 6312 (relating to sexual abuse of children),
- 17 specifying variations from the range of sentences applicable
- 18 based on such aggravating circumstances as the age of the child
- 19 or a determination of prepubescence, the number of images
- 20 possessed by the defendant, if the child depicted is known to
- 21 the defendant and the nature and character of the abuse depicted
- 22 in the images.
- 23 (b) Other circumstances. -- When a person commits an offense
- 24 to which the grading provisions under 18 Pa.C.S. § 6312(d.1)(3)
- 25 apply, the Pennsylvania Commission on Sentencing shall, in
- 26 accordance with section 2154, provide for a sentence enhancement
- 27 <u>within its guidelines if indecent contact with the child as</u>
- 28 defined in 18 Pa.C.S. § 3101 (relating to definitions) is
- 29 <u>depicted and the child depicted is under 10 years of age or</u>
- 30 prepubescent.

1 Section 4. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
