REFERRED TO TRANSPORTATION, OCTOBER 14, 2021

AN ACT

1 Designating a bridge, identified as Bridge Key 41272, on that
 2 portion of Pennsylvania Route 286 over Crooked Creek, Rayne
 3 Township, Indiana County, as the Sergeant First Class Randy
 4 McCaulley Memorial Bridge.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
 6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Sergeant First Class Randy McCaulley Memorial
 8 Bridge.

9 (a) Findings.--The General Assembly finds and declares as
 10 follows:

11 (1) Sergeant First Class Randy McCaulley enlisted in the
 12 Army after graduating from Marion Center High School in 1979
 13 and served for four years.

14 (2) In 1984, SFC McCaulley joined the Pennsylvania
 15 National Guard and was assigned to Company A, 1st Battalion,
 16 110th Infantry based in Indiana, Pennsylvania.

17 (3) Company A, which included SFC McCaulley, was
 18 mobilized in January 2005 and arrived for service in June
 19 2005 with the 2nd Brigade Combat Team in Ramadi, about 65

1 miles west of Baghdad.

2 (4) On March 23, 2006, SFC McCaulley was shot and killed
3 by small arms fire while on a combat patrol with his unit in
4 Mudiq, Iraq.

5 (5) The Pennsylvania National Guard posthumously
6 promoted SFC McCaulley from staff sergeant to sergeant first
7 class and he was awarded the Purple Heart.

8 (b) Designation.--The bridge, identified as Bridge Key
9 41272, located on Pennsylvania Route 286 over Crooked Creek in
10 Rayne Township, Indiana County, is designated the Sergeant First
11 Class Randy McCaulley Memorial Bridge.

12 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and
13 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge to
14 traffic in both directions on the bridge.

15 Section 2. Effective date.

16 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
