AN ACT

Amending the act of September 30, 1983 (P.L.160, No.39), entitled "An act establishing salaries and compensation of 2 certain public officials including justices and judges of 3 Statewide courts, judges of courts of common pleas, judges of the Philadelphia Municipal Court, judges of the Philadelphia 5 Traffic Court, district justices and the Governor, the Lieutenant Governor, the State Treasurer, the Auditor 6 7 General, the Attorney General and certain other State 8 officers and the salary and certain expenses of the members 9 of the General Assembly; and repealing certain inconsistent 10 acts," further providing for judicial salaries, for executive 11 salaries and for legislative salaries; and making a repeal. 12 13 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 14 hereby enacts as follows: 15 Section 1. Sections 2.1(i), 3(e) and 4(d) and (d.1) of the 16 act of September 30, 1983 (P.L.160, No.39), known as the Public 17 Official Compensation Law, are amended to read: Section 2.1. Judicial salaries. 18 19 20 (i) Annual cost-of-living adjustment. --21 Except as provided under paragraph (2), beginning] Beginning January 1, 1997, and each January 1 thereafter, the 22 23 annual salaries under subsections (a) through (h) shall be

The percentage increase and the new compensation 18 amounts shall be determined jointly by the Chief Clerk of the 19 Senate and the Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives 20 prior to the annual effective date of the adjustment and 21 shall be published in the Pennsylvania Bulletin within 20 22 days immediately prior to each cost-of-living increase taking effect. 23 [(2) The additional compensation of the officers and 24 25 leaders of the General Assembly may not be increased by an

[(2) The additional compensation of the officers and leaders of the General Assembly may not be increased by an annual cost-of-living adjustment under paragraph (1) for the period beginning December 1, 2020, through November 30, 2021. Notice of the provisions of this subsection shall be transmitted to the Legislative Reference Bureau for publication in the Pennsylvania Bulletin prior to December 1,

- section 2.1(i) of the act.
- 24 (2) 42 Pa.C.S. § 1741(b) is repealed insofar as it is
- inconsistent with the amendment of section 2.1(i) of the act.
- 26 Section 4. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
