## AN ACT

Amending the act of August 9, 1955 (P.L.323, No.130), entitled, as amended, "An act relating to counties of the first, second 2 class A, third, fourth, fifth, sixth, seventh and eighth 3 classes; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto; relating to imposition of excise taxes 5 by counties, including authorizing imposition of an excise 6 tax on the rental of motor vehicles by counties of the first 7 class; and providing for regional renaissance initiatives," 8 in district attorney, assistants and detectives, further 9 10 providing for filling of vacancies. 11 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 12 hereby enacts as follows: 13 Section 1. Section 1404(b) of the act of August 9, 1955 14 (P.L.323, No.130), known as The County Code, amended October 24, 15 2018 (P.L.931, No.154), is amended to read: Section 1404. Filling of Vacancies. -- \* \* \* 16 17 If any vacancy shall occur in the office of district 18 attorney in a county of the fourth through eighth class, the 19 judges of the court of common pleas shall, upon a showing that 20 the first assistant district attorney [shall become] satisfies the requirements of section 1401, appoint the first assistant 21

district attorney to fill the office of district attorney and to

- 1 discharge the duties of the district attorney until the first
- 2 Monday in January following the next municipal election
- 3 occurring not less than ninety days after the occurrence of the
- 4 vacancy. If the first assistant district attorney is unwilling
- 5 or unable to serve or does not satisfy the requirements of
- 6 <u>section 1401</u>, the judges of the court of common pleas shall fill
- 7 the vacancy by the appointment of a competent person who
- 8 <u>satisfies the requirements of section 1401</u> to fill the office
- 9 until the first Monday in January following the next municipal
- 10 election occurring not less than ninety days after the
- 11 occurrence of the vacancy.
- 12 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
