## AN ACT

1 2	Providing for parental consent for virtual mental health services provided by a school entity.
3	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
4	hereby enacts as follows:
5	Section 1. Short title.
6	This act shall be known and may be cited as the Virtual
7	Mental Health IN SCHOOLS Act. <
8	Section 2. Definitions.
9	The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
10	have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
11	context clearly indicates otherwise:
12	"School entity." A public school, including a charter school
13	or cyber charter school, private school, nonpublic school,
14	intermediate unit or area career and technical school operating
15	within this Commonwealth.
16	"Virtual mental health services." Online support, ONLINE <
17	PEER SUPPORT COMMUNITY or counseling provided by an individual,

1 who is not a licensed mental health professional in this
2 Commonwealth, or application. The presence or ability of one <-3 individual not licensed in this Commonwealth to engage with
4 students shall meet the requirements of this definition.</pre>

5 Section 3. Parental consent to virtual mental health services6 provided by a school entity.

7 (a) Application.--This act applies to all virtual mental
8 health services provided by or in coordination with a school
9 entity.

10 (b) Form requirements.--The school entity shall create a 11 form for obtaining virtual mental health services, which shall 12 contain the following:

13 (1) A summary and scope of the virtual mental health14 services available.

15 (2) An area for parents or guardians to provide consent.
16 (3) Any other information the school entity deems
17 necessary.

(c) Obtaining consent. -- Notwithstanding SECTION 1.1(2) OF 18 <---19 THE ACT OF FEBRUARY 13, 1970 (P.L.19, NO.10), ENTITLED "AN ACT 20 ENABLING CERTAIN MINORS TO CONSENT TO MEDICAL, DENTAL AND HEALTH 21 SERVICES, DECLARING CONSENT UNNECESSARY UNDER CERTAIN 22 CIRCUMSTANCES," OR any other provision of law OR REGULATION, a <---23 school entity providing or coordinating virtual mental health 24 services shall, no later than 14 days after the beginning of the <--25 school year, ANNUALLY obtain a completed form with the consent <---26 of the parent or quardian of a student who is under 18 years of age prior to providing or coordinating virtual mental health 27 28 services to the student.

29 (d) Consent required.--A school entity may not provide or30 coordinate any virtual mental health services for a student

3 Section 4. Effective date.

4 This act shall take effect on July 1, 2024, or immediately, 5 whichever is later.
