AN ACT

- Amending the act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), entitled "An act concerning elections, including general, municipal, 1 2 special and primary elections, the nomination of candidates, 3 primary and election expenses and election contests; creating and defining membership of county boards of elections; imposing duties upon the Secretary of the Commonwealth, courts, county boards of elections, county commissioners; imposing penalties for violation of the act, and codifying, 6 7 8 revising and consolidating the laws relating thereto; and 9 repealing certain acts and parts of acts relating to 10 elections," in voting by qualified mail-in electors, 11 providing for moratorium on voting by mail-in ballot. 12 13 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 14 hereby enacts as follows: 15 Section 1. The act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), known as the Pennsylvania Election Code, is amended by adding a 16 17 section to read: 18 Section 1309-D. Moratorium on voting by mail-in ballot. (a) Moratorium. -- Voting by an official mail-in ballot in any 19 20 election held in this Commonwealth in the manner provided under 21 this article shall be suspended until the earlier of the
- 22 following:

- 1 (1) The commencement of the election process regarding
- 2 <u>the 2023 primary election.</u>
- 3 (2) Notice under subsection (b).
- 4 (b) Notice. -- Upon enactment of legislation that addresses
- 5 any problem associated with voting by an official mail-in
- 6 ballot, the President pro tempore of the Senate and the Speaker
- 7 of the House of Representatives shall transmit notice of the
- 8 <u>enactment to the Legislative Reference Bureau for publication in</u>
- 9 <u>the Pennsylvania Bulletin.</u>
- 10 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
