AN ACT

1 Amending the act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), entitled  
 2 "An act concerning elections, including general, municipal,  
 3 special and primary elections, the nomination of candidates,  
 4 primary and election expenses and election contests; creating  
 5 and defining membership of county boards of elections;  
 6 imposing duties upon the Secretary of the Commonwealth,  
 7 courts, county boards of elections, county commissioners;  
 8 imposing penalties for violation of the act, and codifying,  
 9 revising and consolidating the laws relating thereto; and  
 10 repealing certain acts and parts of acts relating to  
 11 elections," in voting by qualified mail-in electors,  
 12 providing for moratorium on voting by mail-in ballot.

13 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
 14 hereby enacts as follows:

15 Section 1. The act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), known  
 16 as the Pennsylvania Election Code, is amended by adding a  
 17 section to read:

18 Section 1309-D. Moratorium on voting by mail-in ballot.

19 (a) Moratorium.--Voting by an official mail-in ballot in any  
 20 election held in this Commonwealth in the manner provided under  
 21 this article shall be suspended until the earlier of the  
 22 following:

1           (1) The commencement of the election process regarding  
2           the 2023 primary election.

3           (2) Notice under subsection (b).

4           (b) Notice.--Upon enactment of legislation that addresses  
5           any problem associated with voting by an official mail-in  
6           ballot, the President pro tempore of the Senate and the Speaker  
7           of the House of Representatives shall transmit notice of the  
8           enactment to the Legislative Reference Bureau for publication in  
9           the Pennsylvania Bulletin.

10          Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
