AN ACT
Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in registration of vehicles, providing for multiple war veteran plate; and, in fees, further providing for exemption of persons, entities and vehicles from fees.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows:
Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a section to read: § 1369.1. Multiple-war veteran plate.

Upon application of any person who is a veteran of all of the following wars: World War II, the Korean War and the Vietnam Conflict, accompanied by a fee of $\$ 20$ and by such documentation as the department shall require, the department shall issue to such person a special registration plate designating the vehicle so registered as belonging to a person who is a veteran of all of those three wars. The special registration plate may be used only on one passenger vehicle or one other vehicle with a gross weight of not more than 9,000 pounds.

Section 2. Section $1901(c)$ of Title 75 is amended by adding a paragraph to read:
§ 1901. Exemption of persons, entities and vehicles from fees.

(c) Processing fee in lieu of registration fee.--No registration fee shall be charged for vehicles registered by any of the following but the department shall charge a fee of $\$ 10$ to
cover the costs of processing for issuing or renewing the
registration:

(24) Any veteran who served in all of the following
wars: World War II, the Korean War and the Vietnam Conflict.

Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
