- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. Section 6 of the act of October 10, 1975
- 10 (P.L.383, No.110), known as the Physical Therapy Practice Act,
- is amended by adding a subsection to read: 11
- 12 Section 6. Qualifications for License; Examinations; Failure
- 13 of Examinations; Licensure Without Examination; Issuing of
- License; Foreign Applicants for Licensure; Temporary License; 14
- Perjury. -- * * * 15
- 16 (k) The board shall require an applicant for a licensure to
- 17 submit to a criminal history background check conducted by the
- Pennsylvania State Police. The applicant shall submit 18
- fingerprints and other identifying information to the 19

- 1 Pennsylvania State Police. The board may not consider an
- 2 applicant for an initial license who refuses to comply with this
- 3 subsection. The following shall apply:
- 4 (1) In order to assist the board in reviewing the criminal
- 5 <u>history background of an applicant for a licensure, the</u>
- 6 Pennsylvania State Police or its designee shall do the
- 7 <u>following:</u>
- 8 (i) Provide the board with a report of the applicant's
- 9 criminal history record information as defined in 18 Pa.C.S. §
- 10 9102 (relating to definitions) or a statement that the
- 11 Pennsylvania State Police central repository contains no
- 12 <u>information relating to the applicant. The criminal history</u>
- 13 record information under this subparagraph shall be subject to
- 14 <u>18 Pa.C.S. § 9121(b)(2) (relating to general regulations).</u>
- 15 (ii) Submit the applicant's fingerprints to the Federal
- 16 Bureau of Investigation for a national criminal history records
- 17 check.
- 18 (iii) Provide the board with the national criminal history
- 19 record information of the applicant. The information provided
- 20 under this subparagraph shall not be subject to 18 Pa.C.S. §
- 21 9121(b)(2).
- 22 (2) Criminal history record information obtained by the
- 23 board under this section shall be interpreted and used only to
- 24 determine an applicant's eligibility for an initial license.
- 25 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
