13	(16) All property owned by an entity that is organized
14	under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986
15	<u>(Public Law 99-514, 26 U.S.C. § 501(c)(3)) as a conservancy</u>
16	that has the primary function to preserve open space, natural
17	areas or wildlife. In addition to any land owned by the
18	conservancy, all buildings, enterprises and improvements
19	within the grounds or annexed to the grounds that are
