## AN ACT

- Amending the act of April 17, 2016 (P.L.84, No.16), entitled "An act establishing a medical marijuana program; providing for 2 patient and caregiver certification and for medical marijuana 3 organization registration; imposing duties on the Department of Health; providing for a tax on medical marijuana 5 organization gross receipts; establishing the Medical 6 7 Marijuana Program Fund; establishing the Medical Marijuana Advisory Board; establishing a medical marijuana research 8 program; imposing duties on the Department of Corrections, 9 the Department of Education and the Department of Human 10 Services; and providing for academic clinical research 11 centers and for penalties and enforcement," in medical 12 marijuana organizations, providing for reissuance of permits 13 and further providing for limitations on permits. 14 15 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 16 hereby enacts as follows: 17 Section 1. Section 611 of the act of April 17, 2016 (P.L.84, 18 No.16), known as the Medical Marijuana Act, is amended to read: 19 Section 611. [(Reserved).] Reissuance of permits. 20 (a) Grower/processor permit. -- If a grower/processor permit 21 issued under this act, excluding permits issued under section 22 2002, is surrendered, revoked or otherwise forfeited within two years from the date of initial issuance, the department shall 23
- 24 issue the grower/processor permit to the next most qualified

- 1 applicant in the same region according to the department's
- 2 ranking and scoring in the application phase during which the
- 3 initial permit was issued.
- 4 (b) Dispensary permit. -- If a dispensary permit issued under
- 5 this act, excluding permits issued under section 2002, is
- 6 <u>surrendered</u>, revoked or otherwise forfeited within two years
- 7 from the date of initial issuance, the department shall issue
- 8 the dispensary permit to the next most qualified applicant in
- 9 the same county within the same region according to the
- 10 department's ranking and scoring in the application phase during
- 11 which the initial permit was issued.
- 12 Section 2. Section 616 of the act is amended by adding a
- 13 paragraph to read:
- 14 Section 616. Limitations on permits.
- 15 The following limitations apply to approval of permits for
- 16 grower/processors and dispensaries:
- 17 \* \* \*
- 18 (8) A grower/processor or dispensary shall immediately
- 19 <u>surrender all permits granted under section 603 upon</u>
- 20 application to the department to be a clinical registrant
- 21 under section 2002. The department shall reissue, in
- 22 compliance with section 611, any permits that have been
- 23 surrendered under this paragraph.
- 24 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
