AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain
- provisions applicable as well to private and parochial
- schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
- laws relating thereto," in school health services, providing
- for seizure recognition and related first aid training.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
- 10 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a
- 11 section to read:
- 12 <u>Section 1414.11. Seizure Recognition and Related First Aid</u>
- 13 Training. -- Beginning with the school year 2021-2022 and each
- 14 year thereafter:
- 15 (1) A school nurse shall complete a Department of Health
- 16 approved online or in-person course of instruction for school
- 17 nurses regarding management of a student with seizures that
- 18 includes information about seizure recognition, a seizure action
- 19 plan and related first aid.
- 20 (2) A professional employe of a school entity, other than a

- 1 school nurse, whose duties at the school entity include regular
- 2 contact with students shall complete a Department of Health
- 3 online or in-person course of instruction regarding awareness of
- 4 <u>a student with seizures that includes information about seizure</u>
- 5 recognition and related first aid.
- 6 (3) The training required under this section shall be
- 7 <u>credited toward a professional educator's continuing</u>
- 8 professional education requirement under section 1205.2, any
- 9 staff development requirements for paraprofessionals under 22
- 10 Pa. Code § 14.105 (relating to personnel) and a school or system
- 11 leader's continuing professional education requirement under
- 12 section 1205.5.
- 13 <u>(4) The Department of Health may identify, develop or</u>
- 14 approve an online or in-person course of instruction provided by
- 15 a nonprofit national foundation that supports the welfare of
- 16 <u>individuals</u> with epilepsy and seizure disorders to satisfy the
- 17 training required under this section.
- 18 (5) The Department of Health, in consultation with the
- 19 Department of Education, shall adopt guidelines to administer
- 20 this section.
- 21 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
