- 7 nurses, 48,000 licensed practical nurses, 18,000 clinical
- 8 registered nurse practitioners and 250 clinical nurse
- 9 specialists, which makes nursing the largest licensed health
- 10 care profession, based on statistics, in this Commonwealth; and
- 11 WHEREAS, The care provided by the nurses of this Commonwealth
- 12 is the primary component of a successful health care delivery
- 13 system in this Commonwealth; therefore be it
- 14 RESOLVED, That the Senate designate the week of May 6 through
- 15 12, 2023, as "Nurses Week" in Pennsylvania; and be it further
