- Congratulating members of the Pennsylvania State University 1 wrestling team and Pennsylvania residents who competed and 2 placed during the National Collegiate Athletic Association 3
- Division I Wrestling Championship.
- 5 WHEREAS, In his second appearance at the NCAA Championship
- Tournament, the Pennsylvania State University wrestler Roman 6
- Bravo-Young won his first National Collegiate Athletic 7
- Association (NCAA) wrestling title in the 133-pound division;
- 9 and
- 10 WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania State University wrestler Roman
- 11 Bravo-Young earned the All-American distinction for the third
- 12 time, was a Hodge Trophy finalist and ended the season with a
- 13 14-0 record; and
- 14 WHEREAS, In his third appearance at the NCAA Championship
- 15 Tournament, the Pennsylvania State University wrestler Nick Lee
- 16 won his first NCAA wrestling title in the 141-pound division;
- 17 and
- 18 WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania State University wrestler Nick Lee

- 1 earned the distinction of the Pennsylvania State University's
- 2 15th four-time All-American, placed second in the 141-pound
- 3 final of the Big Ten Tournament and was the first NCAA champion
- 4 for the Pennsylvania State University in the 141-pound division
- 5 since the weight classes changed to their current form in 1999;
- 6 and
- 7 WHEREAS, In his first appearance at the NCAA Championship
- 8 Tournament, the Pennsylvania State University wrestler Carter
- 9 Starocci won his first NCAA wrestling title in the 174-pound
- 10 division; and
- 11 WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania State University wrestler Carter
- 12 Starocci earned the All-American distinction for the first time
- 13 and was named 2021 Big Ten Freshman of the Year, becoming the
- 14 Pennsylvania State University's seventh overall and second
- 15 straight Freshman of the Year; and
- 16 WHEREAS, In his first appearance at the NCAA Championship
- 17 Tournament, the Pennsylvania State University wrestler Aaron
- 18 Brooks won his first NCAA wrestling title in the 184-pound
- 19 division; and
- 20 WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania State University wrestler Aaron
- 21 Brooks earned the All-American distinction for the second time,
- 22 was a Hodge Trophy finalist and ended the season with a 14-0
- 23 record; and
- 24 WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania State University Wrestling team
- 25 featured six All-Americans in 2021 and finished second in the
- 26 Big Ten Championships; and
- 27 WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania State University wrestling team
- 28 placed second at the NCAA Division I Wrestling Championship; and
- 29 WHEREAS, In his third appearance at the NCAA Championship
- 30 Tournament, the University of Iowa wrestler and Franklin

- 1 Regional High School graduate Spencer Lee earned his third NCAA
- 2 wrestling title in the 125-pound division while competing with
- 3 two torn anterior cruciate ligaments (ACLs); and
- 4 WHEREAS, Spencer Lee was a co-winner of the 2021 Dan Hodge
- 5 Trophy and earned the All-American distinction for the fourth
- 6 time; and
- WHEREAS, Sammy Sasso, from Nazareth, earned second place in
- 8 the 149-pound division while competing for the Ohio State
- 9 University and earned the All-American distinction for the
- 10 second time; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Jake Wentzel, from South Park, earned second place
- 12 in the 165-pound division while competing for the University of
- 13 Pittsburgh and earned the All-American distinction for the
- 14 second time; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Michael Kemerer, from Murrysville, and another
- 16 graduate from Franklin Regional High School earned second place
- 17 in the 174-pound division while competing for the University of
- 18 Iowa and earned the All-American distinction for the third time;
- 19 and
- 20 WHEREAS, Trent Hidlay, from Lewistown, earned second place in
- 21 the 184-pound division while competing for North Carolina State
- 22 University and earned the All-American distinction for the
- 23 second time; and
- 24 WHEREAS, Nino Bonaccorsi, from Bethel Park, earned second
- 25 place in the 197-pound division while competing for the
- 26 University of Pittsburgh and earned the All-American distinction
- 27 for the second time; and
- 28 WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania State University wrestler Michael
- 29 Beard earned seventh place in the 197-pound division and earned
- 30 the All-American distinction for the first time; and

- 1 WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania State University wrestler Greg
- 2 Kerkvliet earned seventh place in the 285-pound division and
- 3 earned the All-American distinction for the first time; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Of the 330 wrestlers competing at the NCAA Division
- 5 I Wrestling Championship, 50 hailed from Pennsylvania; therefore
- 6 be it
