A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing the week of May 12 through 18, 2019, as "National Hospital Week" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania hospitals and health systems ensure
- 4 that health care services are available in this Commonwealth 24
- 5 hours a day, 7 days a week, providing acute inpatient care as
- 6 well as outpatient, emergency, behavioral health,
- 7 rehabilitation, long-term and home care; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania's 41 trauma centers, 7 burn centers and
- 9 15 critical access hospitals deliver specialized care for the
- 10 most rural populations in this Commonwealth; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania is home to seven medical degree-
- 12 granting schools as well as numerous academic medical centers
- 13 and teaching hospitals that train future health care providers
- 14 and invest in critical health research; and
- 15 WHEREAS, "National Hospital Week" dates back to 1921, in
- 16 Chicago, as an event to build trust following the Spanish

- 1 influenza outbreak; and
- 2 WHEREAS, The observance is a reminder that hospitals are
- 3 foundations of the communities that built them, serving people
- 4 from all walks of life; and
- 5 WHEREAS, "National Hospital Week" celebrates hospitals and
- 6 the people who support the health of their communities with
- 7 dedication and compassion; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania hospitals are multidimensional,
- 9 partnering with other community organizations to offer health
- 10 care services that focus on health promotion, disease prevention
- 11 and wellness; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania hospitals provide free health care
- 13 services to individuals who have no health insurance or
- 14 inadequate health insurance coverage, providing nearly \$778.5
- 15 million in uncompensated care during 2017; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania hospitals contributed more than \$128.9
- 17 billion to this Commonwealth's economy during 2017; and
- 18 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania hospitals are among the leading
- 19 employers in their communities, providing approximately 650,000
- 20 jobs, directly and indirectly; therefore be it
- 21 RESOLVED, That the Senate recognize the week of May 12
- 22 through 18, 2019, as "National Hospital Week" in Pennsylvania;
- 23 and be it further
- 24 RESOLVED, That the Senate urge its members to visit the
- 25 hospitals in their communities to learn about the innovative,
- 26 quality care and services that are improving the health and
- 27 well-being of residents of this Commonwealth.
