A RESOLUTION

- Recognizing the month of May 2019 as "Lupus Awareness Month" and May 10, 2019, as "World Lupus Day" in Pennsylvania to give
- more attention and awareness to the disease.
- WHEREAS, Every day, an estimated 65,000 Pennsylvanians, 1.5
- 5 million Americans and 5 million people worldwide struggle with
- 6 the debilitating consequences of lupus, a potentially fatal
- 7 autoimmune disease that can damage any part of a lupus patient's
- 8 body; and
- 9 WHEREAS, In an autoimmune disease such as lupus, the immune
- 10 system becomes hyperactive and attacks healthy cells, causing
- 11 inflammation and pain and leading to permanent damage; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Lupus has no cure and no known cause and, despite
- 13 the current treatment and available medications, many lupus
- 14 patients have symptoms that cannot be managed well enough for
- 15 patients to lead normal lives, complete their education and
- 16 maintain employment; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Nine out of ten people with lupus are women; and

- 1 WHEREAS, New cases of lupus are diagnosed among women between
- 2 15 and 44 years of age about 80% of the time, with the majority
- 3 of new cases seen in women in their late teens and early 20s;
- 4 and
- 5 WHEREAS, Although the disease is most frequently seen in
- 6 female patients, individuals of any age or gender can develop
- 7 lupus; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Lupus was identified as a disease in 1872 but is an
- 9 underrecognized public health problem that attracts rare
- 10 attention and funding for research for a cure; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Lupus is often referred to as the disease that fools
- 12 due to the patient's unawareness of its presence for extended
- 13 periods of time; and
- 14 WHEREAS, The Lupus Foundation of America Philadelphia Tri-
- 15 State Chapter, a nonprofit volunteer health organization with a
- 16 history of service since the early 1970s, provides supportive
- 17 services to the victims of lupus, funds medical research into
- 18 the disease's causes and possible treatments and educates the
- 19 public concerning the realities of lupus; therefore be it
- 20 RESOLVED, That the Senate recognize the month of May 2019 as
- 21 "Lupus Awareness Month" and May 10, 2019, as "World Lupus Day"
- 22 in Pennsylvania to give more attention and awareness to the
- 23 disease.
