## A RESOLUTION

- Designating the month of August 2023 as "Civic Health Month" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Civic engagement is a critical opportunity for a
- 4 voter to shape the policies that affect the health challenges
- 5 facing the voter's local community; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Civic health describes the capacity of a community
- 7 to address issues that impact the well-being of community
- 8 members through participation in elections and other civic
- 9 engagement activities; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Civic participation gives a voter the ability to
- 11 shape the policies that affect a voter's personal health
- 12 outcomes; and
- 13 WHEREAS, An individual who votes as a form of civic
- 14 participation self-reports better health than an individual who
- 15 does not vote; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Health outcomes may be determined by nonmedical
- 17 factors, including access to food, transportation and affordable
- 18 housing; and

- 1 WHEREAS, Medical professionals have made great strides in
- 2 addressing the underlying social conditions that make their
- 3 patients sick, including hunger, drug addiction and
- 4 homelessness; and
- 5 WHEREAS, By checking civic vital signs, including voter
- 6 registration and participation, when talking to colleagues and
- 7 patients, health care providers can promote better civic health;
- 8 and
- 9 WHEREAS, Nonpartisan voter registration in medical settings
- 10 has been successful in registering patients to vote and
- 11 expanding the number of engaged voters; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Empowering community members to register to vote and
- 13 participate in elections is a critical action health care
- 14 institutions can take to improve not only community-level civic
- 15 health, but also individual-level physical and mental health;
- 16 and
- 17 WHEREAS, More than 200 hospitals, health care associations
- 18 and civic engagement organizations unite to celebrate "Civic
- 19 Health Month" each August; therefore be it
- 20 RESOLVED, That the Senate designate the month of August 2023
- 21 as "Civic Health Month" in Pennsylvania.
