## A RESOLUTION

- Designating the week of June 26 through 30, 2017, as "Middle Neighborhoods Week" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Middle neighborhoods are areas that are seemingly
- 4 stable but in danger of decline because they do not receive the
- 5 same private development as high-income areas or the same amount
- 6 of funding and attention available for lower-income
- 7 neighborhoods; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Middle neighborhoods exist in almost all cities and
- 9 some larger suburbs; and
- 10 WHEREAS, In Philadelphia, more than 40% of the population
- 11 lives in middle neighborhoods, in communities such as
- 12 Rhawnhurst, Roxborough, Mayfair, Mount Airy, Tacony, Germantown,
- 13 Burholme, Port Richmond, Wissinoming and Bridesburg; and
- 14 WHEREAS, The well-being of these neighborhoods is vital for
- 15 the families and individuals living in them; and
- 16 WHEREAS, It is also critical for the overall financial
- 17 stability of many cities and suburbs that rely on the property
- 18 tax base of these neighborhoods; and

- 1 WHEREAS, Should these middle neighborhoods decline in value
- 2 by slipping into distress, local governments will have even
- 3 fewer dollars to provide needed services in these and other
- 4 neighborhoods; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Given the importance of these neighborhoods to the
- 6 cities and suburbs of this Commonwealth, it is unsettling how
- 7 little attention is being paid to ensure that these
- 8 neighborhoods transition into greater health, rather than lapse
- 9 into decline; therefore be it
- 10 RESOLVED, That the Senate designate the week of June 26
- 11 through 30, 2017, as "Middle Neighborhoods Week" in
- 12 Pennsylvania.
