A RESOLUTION

1 2	Designating the week of July 8 through 14, 2019, as "Juror Appreciation Week" in Pennsylvania.
3	WHEREAS, For 228 years, Americans have benefited from the
4	protection offered by the right to trial by an impartial jury
5	guaranteed by the Sixth Amendment to the Constitution of the
6	United States; and
7	WHEREAS, Since the Bill of Rights, which includes the Sixth
8	Amendment, was ratified in December 1791, the jury has acted as
9	an unbiased finder of truth and the most representative body of
10	citizens in our justice system; and
11	WHEREAS, The jury has played a pivotal role in balancing the
12	scales of justice, equalizing the rights of the poor and
13	powerless with the privileges of the rich and powerful, securing
14	other allowed rights guaranteed by the Bill of Rights and, most
15	importantly, extending and preserving democracy; and
16	WHEREAS, Every year more than 225,000 Pennsylvanians report
17	for jury duty and more than 60,000 serve as jurors in civil and

1 criminal trials; and

2 WHEREAS, Only when citizens support the jury system and 3 appear when summoned can this pillar of our democracy fully 4 protect the rights of all citizens; therefore be it 5 RESOLVED, That the Senate designate the week of July 8 6 through 14, 2019, as "Juror Appreciation Week" in Pennsylvania.
