A RESOLUTION

1 Designating June 26, 2015, as "Remember Everyone Deployed Friday
2 (Red Friday)" in Pennsylvania.

3 WHEREAS, Groups have advocated the wearing of red on Fridays
4 to show their support for all members of the armed forces
5 abroad; and

6 WHEREAS, Red Friday was designed as an opportunity for red-
7 blooded Americans to demonstrate their support of the troops who
8 are deployed; and

9 WHEREAS, Friday has been designated as a common day of the
10 week to wear the color red for all the servicemen and
11 servicewomen who are deployed; and

12 WHEREAS, On Red Friday and throughout the year, we honor the
13 commitment these servicemen and servicewomen have made to their
14 country; and

15 WHEREAS, We honor all Pennsylvania and American servicemen
16 and servicewomen and their families for their service and
17 sacrifice; therefore be it

1 RESOLVED, That the Senate designate June 26, 2015, as
2 "Remember Everyone Deployed Friday (Red Friday)" in
3 Pennsylvania.
