## A RESOLUTION

| 1<br>2 | Recognizing June 30, 2017, as "Arthrogryposis Awareness Day" in Pennsylvania. |
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| 3      | WHEREAS, Arthrogryposis, or arthrogryposis multiplex                          |
| 4      | congenita, comprises more than 300 different disorders, all                   |
| 5      | characterized by multiple joint contractures found throughout                 |
| 6      | the body at birth; and  |
| 7      | WHEREAS, "Arthrogryposis" literally means curving of joints,                  |
| 8      | "multiplex" indicates more than one joint is affected and                     |
| 9      | "congenita" indicates the condition is present at birth; and                  |
| 10     | WHEREAS, The most common universal symptom of arthrogryposis                  |
| 11     | is contracture, meaning limited or absent movement around small               |
| 12     | and large joints; and   |
| 13     | WHEREAS, Often the muscles around affected joints are thin,                   |
| 14     | weak, stiff or missing, and extra tissue may have formed around               |
| 15     | the joints holding them in place; and   |
| 16     | WHEREAS, The overall prevalence of arthrogryposis is                          |
| 17     | estimated at 1 in every 3,000 live births; and                                |

1 WHEREAS, The specific symptoms of arthrogryposis and their 2 severity can vary dramatically from one child to another, with 3 some children being mildly affected while others are seriously 4 affected; and

WHEREAS, The most common type of arthrogryposis is called 5 6 amyoplasia, in which the hands, wrists, elbows, shoulders, hips, feet and knees are affected and, in more severe types, every 7 8 joint can be affected, including the jaw and spine; and WHEREAS, Arthrogryposis results from fetal akinesia, which is 9 10 characterized by a lack of fetal movement; and 11 WHEREAS, There is no cure for arthrogryposis, only treatment to reduce the severity of the joint contractures and increase 12 13 muscle strength to maximize the function level of the 14 individual; and

15 WHEREAS, Treatment often includes stretching the joints 16 multiple times per day, serial casting, physical, occupational 17 and speech therapy, splinting, bracing, tendon release and 18 lengthening, surgical bone cutting, called ostcotomy, and 19 external fixators; and

20 WHEREAS, Arthrogryposis may be caused by genetic and 21 environmental factors, although the exact causes of 22 arthrogryposis are unknown; and

23 WHEREAS, More research needs to be done to find the causes of 24 arthrogryposis, to map the genes in genetic types and long-term 25 outcome studies of common surgical procedures performed; 26 therefore be it

27 RESOLVED, That the Senate recognize June 30, 2017, as
28 "Arthrogryposis Awareness Day" in Pennsylvania.

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
