5	WHEREAS, Nearly 32 million Americans cannot read or write,
6	and, in this Commonwealth alone, more than 646,000 working-age
7	adults do not have a high school credential; and
8	WHEREAS, Roughly 1.9 million working-age Pennsylvanians
9	struggle with the most basic literacy skills; and
10	WHEREAS, Language, numeracy, health, finance and digital
11	literacy are essential for individual and collective economic
12	well-being; and
13	WHEREAS, Literacy in these domains is the foundation for
14	additional skill building required to build a thriving
15	workforce; and
16	WHEREAS, A vibrant Pennsylvania economy that is well
17	positioned in the global economy depends on having a literate,
18	skilled population; and
19	WHEREAS, The economic well-being of future generations of

- 1 Pennsylvanians depends on the ability of parents and caregivers
- 2 to impart basic literacy skills; and
- 3 WHEREAS, High school credentials are essential to attain
- 4 additional credentials that lead to family-sustaining careers;

- 6 WHEREAS, The potential of 21% of Pennsylvania adults who need
- 7 basic skills education can be unlocked with adult and family
- 8 literacy education; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Without basic skills, these adults remain trapped in
- 10 low-wage jobs and struggle to support their families; and
- 11 WHEREAS, "National Adult Education and Family Literacy Week"
- 12 highlights the need for the nation to support efforts to ensure
- 13 that everyone has the necessary literacy skills to succeed at
- 14 home, at work and in society; and
- 15 WHEREAS, The Senate supports educators and students enrolled
- 16 in programs throughout this Commonwealth; therefore be it
- 17 RESOLVED, That the Senate recognize the week of September 17
- 18 through 23, 2023, as "National Adult Education and Family
- 19 Literacy Week" in Pennsylvania and encourage all residents to
- 20 participate in activities that support and strengthen family
