A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing the week of September 17 through 23, 2015, as  
2 "Constitution Week" in Pennsylvania.

3 WHEREAS, The Constitution of the United States adopted the  
4 principles upon which our Republic was established; and

5 WHEREAS, September 17, 2015, marks the 228th anniversary of  
6 the framing of the Constitution of the United States by the  
7 Constitutional Convention; and

8 WHEREAS, It is fitting and proper to accord official  
9 recognition to this magnificent document and its memorable  
10 anniversary and to the patriotic celebrations which will  
11 commemorate it; and

12 WHEREAS, Each year, the President of the United States issues  
13 a proclamation that designates the week of September 17 through  
14 23 as "Constitution Week"; therefore be it

15 RESOLVED, That the Senate recognize the week of September 17  
16 through 23, 2015, as "Constitution Week" in Pennsylvania and

1 urge all Pennsylvanians to reaffirm the ideals the Framers of  
2 the Constitution had in 1787 by vigilantly protecting the  
3 freedoms guaranteed to us through this guardian of our  
4 liberties.
