2	RESOLVED, That Senate Rule 14(j) be amended and the rule be

6	(j) Consideration of legislation
7	(1) The prime sponsor of a bill or resolution may
8	request that the chairperson of a standing committee hold a
9	meeting on a bill or resolution introduced and referred to
10	the standing committee. The chairperson shall hold a public
11	meeting within 10 legislative days of receiving a request
12	from the prime sponsor of a bill or resolution. All meetings
13	on bills or resolutions shall be subject to the requirements
14	of 65 Pa.C.S. Ch. 7. The chairperson of a standing committee
15	shall provide reasonable opportunity for public comment or
16	testimony at each meeting.

(2) Within 10 legislative days of a meeting on a bill or
