A RESOLUTION

- Designating the month of October 2015 as "Polish American Heritage Month" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, This year marks the 406th anniversary of Polish
- 4 settlers arriving in the United States; and
- 5 WHEREAS, People of Polish heritage have contributed greatly
- 6 to global advancement and the growth of the United States and
- 7 Pennsylvania in particular in the 406 years since the first
- 8 Polish immigrants settled here; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Polish notables include Ignacy Jan Paderewski, one
- 10 of the most famous and popular pianists of all time and an
- 11 advocate for Polish freedom, who was born 153 years ago in
- 12 Warsaw and who died in 1941 in New York City; and
- 13 WHEREAS, People of Polish heritage have demonstrated
- 14 exceptional skills in the fields of accounting, acting, art,
- 15 dentistry, education, engineering, entertainment, general labor,
- 16 government, law, literature, management, mathematics, medicine,

- 1 the military, music, philosophy, poetry, sports and many other
- 2 endeavors; and
- 3 WHEREAS, People of Polish heritage will mark the 235th
- 4 anniversary of the death of General Casimir Pulaski, father of
- 5 the American cavalry, and the 103rd anniversary of Marie
- 6 Sklodowska Curie's receipt of the Nobel Prize in Chemistry for
- 7 her discovery of radioactive elements polonium and radium; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Polish people are recognized for their strong work
- 9 ethic and outstanding achievements; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Other Polish notables include Revolutionary War hero
- 11 Thaddeus Kosciuszko; Leopold Stokowski, a renowned international
- 12 conductor; Zbigniew Brzezinski, National Security Advisor to
- 13 President Carter; and Edmund Muskie, a United States Senator
- 14 from Maine; and
- WHEREAS, Pennsylvanians of Polish heritage have made many
- 16 contributions to our nation; and
- 17 WHEREAS, These Pennsylvanians include Cardinal John Krol of
- 18 Philadelphia, baseball great Stan Musial of Donora and singer
- 19 Bobby Vinton of Canonsburg; and
- 20 WHEREAS, The Polish people have many reasons to be proud of
- 21 and to celebrate their heritage, culture and the achievements of
- 22 their people; and
- 23 WHEREAS, All Pennsylvanians are grateful for the many
- 24 contributions of Poland and its citizens to our Commonwealth;
- 25 therefore be it
- 26 RESOLVED, That the Senate designate the month of October 2015
- 27 as "Polish American Heritage Month" in Pennsylvania.
