A RESOLUTION

- Designating the week of September 23 through 27, 2019, as "Clean Energy Week" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Across this Commonwealth, clean and readily abundant
- 4 forms of energy are powering more homes and businesses than ever
- 5 before; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania is committed to clean and renewable
- 7 energy that benefits our economy and environment; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Clean and renewable energy is part of this
- 9 Commonwealth's energy future and includes generation from
- 10 multiple renewable resources; and
- 11 WHEREAS, The clean and renewable energy sector is a growing
- 12 part of this Commonwealth's economy, growing at a current rate
- 13 of 6% annually, which is five times faster than Statewide job
- 14 growth, and has been a key driver of economic growth in this
- 15 Commonwealth in recent years, with the number of jobs in the
- 16 clean and renewable energy sector in this Commonwealth now
- 17 standing at more than 90,000; and

- 1 WHEREAS, The production costs of clean and renewable energy
- 2 are now the lowest in United States history, averaging \$45 per
- 3 megawatt hour, and are steadily declining as clean and renewable
- 4 technologies continue to improve; and
- 5 WHEREAS, These trends, emerging through a broad base of
- 6 project developers and investors, especially the Pennsylvania
- 7 banking sector, are making clean and renewable energy projects
- 8 more accessible than ever before to Pennsylvania farms,
- 9 communities and local governments; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Under the recently introduced Senate Bill No. 705
- 11 (2019), the Community Solar Act, Pennsylvania ratepayers can
- 12 join together, reduce their utility bills, increase their use of
- 13 clean and renewable energy and benefit from streamlining of
- 14 regulations and cutting of red tape when building community
- 15 solar projects; and
- 16 WHEREAS, The United States Department of Defense and its
- 17 partners in the Pennsylvania Department of Military and Veterans
- 18 Affairs have, through their infrastructure efficiency upgrades,
- 19 power generation modernization and clean energy generation
- 20 projects at Fort Indiantown Gap and across numerous sites in
- 21 this Commonwealth, set a new standard for National Guard and
- 22 Reserve installations across the country and are continuing to
- 23 promote national security through the domestic development of
- 24 clean and renewable energy, thereby reducing our dependence on
- 25 foreign sources of energy; therefore be it
- 26 RESOLVED, That the Senate designate September 23 through 27,
- 27 2019, as "Clean Energy Week" in Pennsylvania.
