REFERRED TO INTERGOVERNMENTAL OPERATIONS, FEBRUARY 18, 2022

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 Calling for an amendment to the Constitution of the United
2 States via a Convention of the States, pursuant to Article V
3 of the Constitution of the United States, establishing term
4 limits for members of Congress.

5 WHEREAS, The General Assembly, hereby makes an application to
6 Congress as provided by Article V of the Constitution of the
7 United States to call a convention limited to proposing an
8 amendment to the Constitution of the United States to set a
9 limit on the number of terms that a person may be elected as a
10 member of the United States Senate and to set a limit on the
11 number of terms that a person may be elected as a member of the
12 United States House of Representatives; and

13 WHEREAS, This application shall be considered as covering the
14 same subject matter as the applications from other states to
15 Congress to call a convention to set a limit on the number of
16 terms that a person may be elected to the United States Senate
17 and the United States House of Representatives; and

18 WHEREAS, This application shall be aggregated with the same
19 for the purpose of attaining the two-thirds of states necessary

1 to require Congress to call a limited convention on this
2 subject, but shall not be aggregated with any other applications
3 on any other subject; and

4 WHEREAS, This application shall constitute a continuing
5 application in accordance with Article V of the Constitution of
6 the United States until the legislatures of at least two-thirds
7 of the several states have made applications on the same
8 subject; therefore be it

9 RESOLVED (the House of Representatives concurring), That the
10 General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in
11 accordance with Article V of the Constitution of the United
12 States, call for an amendment to set a limit on the number of
13 terms that a person may be elected as a member of the United
14 States Senate and to set a limit on the number of terms that a
15 person may be elected as a member of the United States House of
16 Representatives; and be it further

17 RESOLVED, That copies of this resolution be transmitted to
18 the President of the United States Senate, the Secretary of the
19 United States Senate, the Speaker of the United States House of
20 Representatives, the Clerk of the United States House of
21 Representatives and the Chairman of the Judiciary Committee of
22 the United States House of Representatives, each member of
23 Congress from Pennsylvania and the other 49 state legislatures,
24 requesting their cooperation.
