- 15 WHEREAS, When parents work with schools supported by
- 16 communities in shared partnerships, children become lifelong
- 17 learners and community contributors; and
- 18 WHEREAS, The Commonwealth recognizes the important role that

- 2 in children's learning and education; and
- 3 WHEREAS, The Commonwealth recognizes the importance of high-
- 4 quality early childhood parenting programs and efforts that
- 5 engage parents in their children's early learning; and
- 6 WHEREAS, The Commonwealth is dedicated to providing the high-
- 7 quality education that all children deserve in accessible,
- 8 welcoming environments; therefore be it
- 9 RESOLVED, That the Senate designate November 16, 2017, as
- 10 "Parent Involvement Day" in Pennsylvania, and urge all residents
- 11 to recognize and celebrate the importance of parents and
- 12 families in their children's lives and the vital role they have
- 13 in their children's learning and education.
