- 11 Waymond Caine, Edward Giles Irvin and George Wesley Edmonds
- 12 aimed to combat racial discrimination from the founding of the
- 13 fraternity, focusing largely on achievement in every field of
- 14 human endeavor; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity Incorporated has never
- 16 excluded potential members based on national origin, creed or
- color; and 17
- WHEREAS, Today, Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity Incorporated has 18

- 1 more than 150,000 members with undergraduate and alumni chapters
- 2 in every state of the United States, in addition to
- 3 international chapters in the United Kingdom, Germany, Korea,
- 4 Japan, United States Virgin Islands, Nigeria and South Africa;

- 6 WHEREAS, This Commonwealth is home to 21 undergraduate
- 7 chapters and numerous alumni chapters; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity Incorporated promotes
- 9 programs impacting community service, social welfare and
- 10 academic scholarship upon the community via the Kappa Alpha Psi
- 11 Foundation; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity Incorporated celebrated
- 13 its 100th anniversary on January 5, 2011, and is distinguished
- 14 as only the second predominantly African-American collegiate
- 15 fraternity to do so; therefore be it
