A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

- Calling for amendments to the Constitution of the United States in accordance with Article V to establish 12-year term limits 2 for Justices of the United States Supreme Court and to allow 3 a supermajority in Congress or a supermajority among the 4 states to override United States Supreme Court decisions. 5 6 WHEREAS, The Federal judiciary has drifted from the intent of the Constitution of the United States as set forth in its own 7 8 decision, Marbury v. Madison; and 9 WHEREAS, That case, decided in 1803, established the 10 precedent for judicial power and the role of the United States 11 Supreme Court in striking down acts of Congress which conflict 12 with the Constitution of the United States; and 13 WHEREAS, The United States Supreme Court has instead used its 14 power to interpret and expand the Constitution, which has 15 weakened the foundation of our constitutional republic, 16 disrupting order and the original social compact among the 17 Federal Government and the states; and 18 WHEREAS, By using its power in this way the United States
- 20 be restrained under the checks and balances provided by the

Supreme Court is in effect making law, and such power needs to

- 1 Constitution of the United States; and
- 2 WHEREAS, Examples of lawmaking by the United States Supreme
- 3 Court throughout our history include: Dred Scott v. Sandford
- 4 (endorsing slavery), *Plessy v. Ferguson* (affirming segregation)
- 5 and Korematsu v. United States (upholding the interment of
- 6 Americans); therefore be it
- RESOLVED, (the House of Representatives concurring), That the
- 8 General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in
- 9 accordance with Article V of the Constitution of the United
- 10 States, call for an amendment of the Constitution of the United
- 11 States limiting the Justices of the United States Supreme Court
- 12 to a single 12-year term of office with no possibility of
- 13 serving another term or renomination; and be it further
- 14 RESOLVED, That the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of
- 15 Pennsylvania call for an amendment to the Constitution of the
- 16 United States allowing a supermajority in Congress or a
- 17 supermajority among the states to override United States Supreme
- 18 Court decisions; and be it further
- 19 RESOLVED, That copies of this resolution be transmitted to
- 20 the President of the United States, to the presiding officers of
- 21 each house of Congress, to the other 49 state legislatures and
- 22 to each member of Congress from Pennsylvania.
