## A RESOLUTION

- Designating the week of May 6 through 12, 2022, as "Nurses Week" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, "National Nurses Week" begins May 6 and ends May 12
- 4 each year, in conjunction with Florence Nightingale's birthday;
- 5 and
- 6 WHEREAS, This Commonwealth has more than 228,000 registered
- 7 nurses, including more than 49,000 licensed practical nurses and
- 8 more than 16,600 advanced practice registered nurses, which
- 9 makes nursing the largest licensed health care profession, based
- 10 on statistics, in this Commonwealth; and
- 11 WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania State Nurses Association (PSNA) is
- 12 the Statewide association representing the interests of
- 13 professional registered nurses; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Established in 1903, PSNA has been essential in
- 15 advocating, leading, educating and connecting nurses to improve
- 16 health for patients in this Commonwealth for more than 119
- 17 years; and

- 1 WHEREAS, PSNA is working diligently to create a healthier
- 2 Commonwealth that relies on increasing the delivery of nursing
- 3 care through primary and preventive health care; and
- 4 WHEREAS, The care provided by the nurses of this Commonwealth
- 5 is the primary component of a successful health care delivery
- 6 system in this Commonwealth; therefore be it
- 7 RESOLVED, That the Senate designate the week of May 6 through
- 8 12, 2022, as "Nurses Week" in Pennsylvania; and be it further
- 9 RESOLVED, That the Senate join PSNA and other nursing
- 10 organizations in recognizing the selfless service of
- 11 Pennsylvania's nurses and the overall importance of quality
- 12 nursing care.
