A RESOLUTION

- Designating May 29, 2022, as "College and Career Savings Day" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania 529 College and Career Savings
- 4 Program was signed into law as the "Tuition Account Programs and
- 5 College and Career Savings Bond Act" on April 3, 1992; and
- 6 WHEREAS, The PA 529 College and Career Savings Program gives
- 7 Pennsylvania residents a tax-advantaged way to save for
- 8 postsecondary education, reducing the need for borrowing; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Citizens of this Commonwealth can choose to save
- 10 through the PA 529 Guaranteed Savings Plan, in which savings
- 11 grow based on college tuition inflation, or the PA 529
- 12 Investment Plan, in which savings grow based on investment
- 13 decisions and market performance; and
- 14 WHEREAS, The PA 529 Investment Plan was awarded the
- 15 Morningstar Silver Rating in 2020 and again in 2021, designating
- 16 it as a best-in-class plan nationwide based on its design and
- 17 affordability; and
- 18 WHEREAS, PA 529 accounts offer generous tax benefits,

- 1 including a State income tax deduction for contributions, no
- 2 Federal or State income taxes on investment growth, tax-free
- 3 withdrawals for qualified expenses and gift and inheritance tax
- 4 benefits, and PA 529 account assets have no effect on
- 5 Pennsylvania State financial aid eligibility; and
- 6 WHEREAS, More than 273,000 PA 529 accounts, including more
- 7 than 109,300 Guaranteed Savings Plan accounts and more than
- 8 163,900 Investment Plan accounts, currently hold nearly \$7
- 9 billion in savings; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Savings in PA 529 accounts can be used to help pay
- 11 for tuition, fees, equipment, books, room and board and other
- 12 qualified expenses at most schools nationwide, including four-
- 13 year colleges and universities, community colleges, technical
- 14 schools and qualified apprenticeship programs; and
- 15 WHEREAS, The Treasury Department has the statutory
- 16 responsibility to administer the PA 529 College and Career
- 17 Savings Program; and
- 18 WHEREAS, Designating May 29, 2022, as "College and Career
- 19 Savings Day" serves to increase public understanding and
- 20 appreciation of the value of saving for postsecondary education
- 21 through the PA 529 College and Career Savings Program; therefore
- 22 be it
- 23 RESOLVED, That the Senate designate May 29, 2022, as "College
- 24 and Career Savings Day" in Pennsylvania.
