A RESOLUTION

- Designating the week of May 5 through 11, 2024, as "Jewish Day Schools Week" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania is home to 30 Jewish day schools, and
- 4 enrollment in Jewish day schools in Pennsylvania is at an all-
- 5 time high; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania is home to more than 440,000 people of
- 7 Jewish faith or ancestry who have strengthened the fabric of
- 8 this Commonwealth and whose community schools help to continue
- 9 passing on the culture, religion and language to the future
- 10 generations of Jewish Pennsylvanians; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Jewish education plays a unique role in the
- 12 continued vitality of the American Jewish community, providing a
- 13 sense of Jewish pride and an immersive and content-rich Jewish
- 14 environment that has impacted generations of Jewish learners and
- 15 leaders; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Jewish day schools, like Jewish houses of worship
- 17 and other Jewish institutions, have increasingly been the target

- 1 of antisemitic attacks and threats of violence; and
- 2 WHEREAS, In the face of antisemitism, many Jewish families
- 3 value Jewish day schools for offering a supportive community
- 4 where children are nurtured, an environment that promotes Jewish
- 5 values and a quality education; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Jewish day schools provide a conduit for outreach to
- 7 the worldwide Jewish community, promote foreign exchange
- 8 educational opportunities for members of those overseas
- 9 communities to study in Pennsylvania and provide a connection to
- 10 Jewish congregations abroad; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Jewish day schools expand opportunities in
- 12 Pennsylvania and local communities for bilingual education and
- 13 intercultural exchange; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Jewish day schools have taught many individuals who
- 15 have contributed to the culture of the world, this country and
- 16 this Commonwealth, including Seth Rogan, Natalie Portman, Jake
- 17 Tapper and Ralph Lauren; therefore be it
- 18 RESOLVED, That the Senate designate the week of May 5 through
- 19 11, 2024, as "Jewish Day Schools Week" in Pennsylvania and
- 20 express appreciation and gratitude to Jewish day schools across
- 21 this Commonwealth.
