A RESOLUTION

1 Designating the month of February 2014 as "Career and Technical
2 Education Month" in Pennsylvania.

3 WHEREAS, The observance of Career and Technical Education
4 Month serves to increase public understanding and appreciation
5 of the value of career and technical education; and

6 WHEREAS, Career and technical education must serve the needs
7 of business and industry by delivering programs which meet
8 national skill standards and offer recognized credentials; and

9 WHEREAS, This year's theme, "A Cut Above the Rest: Career and
10 Technical Education" represents Pennsylvania's career and
11 technical schools, comprehensive high schools and postsecondary
12 institutions where teachers work to provide the academic and
13 occupational technical skills that prepare our students for the
14 emerging work force; and

15 WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania Association of Career and Technical
16 Administrators strives to promote excellence in career and
17 technical education through leadership, advocacy and service;

1 WHEREAS, All citizens have the right to quality, affordable
2 and accessible career and technical education in this
3 Commonwealth; therefore be it
