A RESOLUTION

- Designating August 4, 2024, as "BAPS Day" in Pennsylvania. 1
- WHEREAS, BAPS Swaminarayan Sanstha ("BAPS") is a worldwide 2
- 3 Hindu denomination dedicated to fostering faith, inspiring
- service and promoting better living; and
- 5 WHEREAS, His Holiness Pramukh Swami Maharaj, (1921-2016),
- established the first BAPS Hindu mandir in the United States on 6
- August 4, 1974, in New York City; and 7
- 8 WHEREAS, The year 2024 marks 50 years of service and faith in
- 9 the United States for BAPS; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Over the past 50 years, BAPS has grown to more than
- 11 100 mandirs across the United States; and
- WHEREAS, These mandirs offer a welcoming and spiritual space 12
- 13 for thousands of families, as well as worship, fellowship,
- 14 communal meals, education and activities for young and old,
- 15 creating a true home for the faithful; and
- 16 WHEREAS, BAPS mandirs offer youth activities that encourage
- and mold young people to live lives of integrity and character 17

- 1 that reflect our highest ideals; and
- 2 WHEREAS, BAPS mandirs bring His Holiness Pramukh Swami
- 3 Maharaj's words, "In the joy of others lies our own," of life
- 4 through support for those in need, through a variety of
- 5 community efforts such as health fairs, food drives or disaster
- 6 relief work; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Following in the example of His Holiness Mahant
- 8 Swami Maharaj, the volunteers of BAPS have, time and again,
- 9 answered the call to serve humbly, selflessly and
- 10 inspirationally; and
- 11 WHEREAS, BAPS mandirs have a storied history of helping
- 12 immigrants to the United States retain their connection to their
- 13 faith but fully embrace and join in American civic life; and
- 14 WHEREAS, BAPS mandirs add to the rich tapestry of diversity
- 15 that makes America and Pennsylvania a beautiful place to call
- 16 home; and
- 17 WHEREAS, The BAPS mandirs in Pennsylvania are proud examples
- 18 of how houses of worship contribute to the well-being of their
- 19 congregants and local communities; and
- 20 WHEREAS, The BAPS mandirs in Pennsylvania hope to serve their
- 21 congregants and the local community with even greater zeal in
- 22 the next 50 years and beyond; therefore be it
- 23 RESOLVED, That the Senate designate August 4, 2024, as "BAPS
- 24 Day" in Pennsylvania; and be it further
- 25 RESOLVED, That the Senate recognize the commitment of BAPS
- 26 Swaminarayan Sanstha in Pennsylvania.
