## A RESOLUTION

- Recognizing the week of May 10 through May 16, 2020, as "National Hospital Week" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania hospitals and health systems ensure
- 4 health care services are available in this Commonwealth 24 hours
- 5 a day, 7 days a week, providing acute inpatient care as well as
- 6 outpatient, emergency, behavioral health, rehabilitation, long-
- 7 term and home care services; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Specialized hospital care is provided by
- 9 Pennsylvania's 41 trauma centers, 7 burn centers and the 15
- 10 critical access hospitals that provide care for the most rural
- 11 populations in this Commonwealth; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania is home to 7 medical degree-granting
- 13 medical schools, 289 nursing programs and numerous academic
- 14 medical centers and teaching hospitals that train future health
- 15 care providers and invest in critical health research; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Originating in Chicago, "National Hospital Week"
- 17 dates back to 1921 as an event to build trust during the Spanish

- 1 influenza outbreak; and
- 2 WHEREAS, The celebration serves as a reminder that hospitals
- 3 are foundations of the communities that built them and serve
- 4 people from all walks of life in every community; and
- 5 WHEREAS, "National Hospital Week" celebrates hospitals and
- 6 the women and men who support the health of their communities
- 7 through dedication and compassionate care; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Today, Pennsylvania hospitals are multidimensional
- 9 organizations that partner with many other organizations in
- 10 their communities to offer care with a focus on population
- 11 health, disease prevention and wellness; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania hospitals provide free care to those
- 13 who have none or inadequate health care insurance coverage; and
- WHEREAS, Pennsylvania hospitals provided nearly \$764.8
- 15 million in uncompensated care during 2018; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania hospitals contributed more than \$136.1
- 17 billion to this Commonwealth's economy during 2018; and
- 18 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania hospitals are among the leading
- 19 employers in their communities, providing approximately 654,000
- 20 total jobs, directly and indirectly; therefore be it
- 21 RESOLVED, That the Senate recognize the week of May 10
- 22 through May 16, 2020, as "National Hospital Week" in
- 23 Pennsylvania; and be it further
- 24 RESOLVED, That the Senate urge its members to visit the
- 25 hospitals in their communities to learn about the innovative,
- 26 quality care and services that are improving the health and
- 27 quality of life for residents of this Commonwealth.
