A RESOLUTION

- Designating April 28, 2016, as "Workers' Memorial Day" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Every year on April 28, communities and worksites
- 4 around the world honor friends, family members and colleagues
- 5 who have been killed or injured on the job; and
- 6 WHEREAS, The Federal Bureau of Labor Statistics has reported
- 7 that in 2014, nearly 4,700 workers suffered fatal workplace
- 8 injuries and nearly 3.4 million workers suffered nonfatal work-
- 9 related injuries and illnesses, and experts estimate that at
- 10 least 50,000 deaths occur annually as a result of occupational
- 11 diseases; and
- 12 WHEREAS, In 2014, 175 workers, up from 163 workers in 2012,
- 13 were lost through fatal workplace accidents in this
- 14 Commonwealth; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Fatal occupational injuries in this Commonwealth
- 16 have ranged from a high of 354 cases in 1994 to a low of 163
- 17 cases in 2012; and

- 1 WHEREAS, In 2012, the number of fatal workplace injuries
- 2 nationwide almost doubled for workers under 16 years of age, the
- 3 highest level since 2005; and
- 4 WHEREAS, In 2012, the construction industry sector, including
- 5 specialty trade contractors, had the largest number of
- 6 fatalities in this Commonwealth, followed by the transportation
- 7 and warehousing sector and agricultural sector; and
- 8 WHEREAS, While news reports often focus our attention on
- 9 disastrous workplace events, most fatal accidents occur with
- 10 little public attention; and
- 11 WHEREAS, It is appropriate to honor the memory of the
- 12 courageous and dedicated members of this Commonwealth's labor
- 13 force who have been injured, disabled or have died as a result
- 14 of workplace accidents; and
- WHEREAS, Recognition of the integrity of this Commonwealth's
- 16 work force and its achievements on behalf of the economic growth
- 17 of our Commonwealth is necessary; and
- 18 WHEREAS, It is appropriate to call for vigilance and
- 19 increased safety in the workplace; and
- 20 WHEREAS, The Senate of Pennsylvania wishes to pay tribute to
- 21 workers who have died or who have been injured or disabled in
- 22 workplace accidents, to honor the contributions of this
- 23 Commonwealth's work force and to call for increased workplace
- 24 safety; therefore be it
- 25 RESOLVED, That the Senate designate April 28, 2016, as
- 26 "Workers' Memorial Day" in Pennsylvania.
