A RESOLUTION

- Designating the month of October 2022 as "Sudden Cardiac Arrest Awareness Month" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention
- 4 reports that heart disease is the leading cause of death in the
- 5 United States; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Sudden cardiac arrest is the largest cause of
- 7 natural death in the United States, responsible for half of all
- 8 heart disease deaths; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Sudden cardiac arrest is the number one killer of
- 10 student athletes and is the leading cause of death on school
- 11 campuses; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Every hour of every day a student dies from sudden
- 13 cardiac arrest, and the survival rate for sudden cardiac arrest
- 14 is less than 10%; and
- 15 WHEREAS, The administration of bystander CPR and the use of
- 16 an automated external defibrillator can significantly increase
- 17 survival rates of sudden cardiac arrest; and

- 1 WHEREAS, Standard physicals and sports physicals do not
- 2 include a routine heart screening using an electrocardiogram
- 3 test that can identify underlying heart issues that could lead
- 4 to sudden cardiac arrest; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Act 73 of 2020, known as Peyton's Law, requires
- 6 information to be provided to parents and guardians of student
- 7 athletes regarding the option to request an electrocardiogram
- 8 test during sports physicals; and
- 9 WHEREAS, There is a need for comprehensive educational
- 10 efforts designed to increase awareness of sudden cardiac arrest
- 11 among medical professionals and the greater public; and
- 12 WHEREAS, The establishment of "Sudden Cardiac Arrest
- 13 Awareness Month" provides the opportunity to raise awareness
- 14 about sudden cardiac arrest and promote early detection through
- 15 heart screenings, proper treatment and prompt response that can
- 16 save the life of someone experiencing sudden cardiac arrest;
- 17 therefore be it
- 18 RESOLVED, That the Senate designate the month of October 2022
- 19 as "Sudden Cardiac Arrest Awareness Month" in Pennsylvania.
