A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing the month of March 2019 as "National Athletic
2 Training Month" in Pennsylvania.

3 WHEREAS, Licensed athletic trainers have a long history of
4 providing quality health care based on specific tasks, knowledge
5 and skills acquired through their nationally regulated
6 educational processes; and

7 WHEREAS, Athletic trainers provide education on the
8 prevention of injuries, recognition, evaluation and aggressive
9 treatment and rehabilitation of injuries, health care
10 administration, research and guidance and compassionate care for
11 all; and

12 WHEREAS, The National Athletic Trainers' Association
13 represents and supports more than 44,000 members of the athletic
14 training profession employed in many settings, including
15 professional sports, colleges and universities, high schools,
16 clinics and hospitals, corporate and industrial settings,
17 performing arts and the military; and

18 WHEREAS, Leading organizations concerned with athletic

1 training and health care have joined together in a common desire
2 to raise public awareness of the importance of the athletic
3 training profession and to emphasize the importance of quality
4 health care within all settings in which athletic trainers are
5 employed; and

6 WHEREAS, Efforts such as these will improve health care for
7 patients and promote licensed athletic trainers as health
8 professionals; therefore be it

9 RESOLVED, That the Senate recognize the month of March 2019
10 as "National Athletic Training Month" in Pennsylvania and urge
11 the people of this Commonwealth to learn more about the
12 importance of athletic training.
