A RESOLUTION

1 Designating the day before Thanksgiving, the Sunday after  
2 Christmas and New Year's Day, at 6 p.m., a time to ring bells  
3 throughout this Commonwealth for five minutes as a sign of  
4 thanks, praise and unity.

5 WHEREAS, Bells have carried a message for hundreds of years,  
6 whether as a warning of disaster, in sorrow and tragedy or as an  
7 act of celebratory ringing; and

8 WHEREAS, Bells are rung to gather people together both  
9 physically and emotionally; and

10 WHEREAS, Ringing bells may lighten the hearts and give hope  
11 to Pennsylvanians in all walks of life; and

12 WHEREAS, A choir of bells ringing in unison may bring people  
13 together in a common attempt to overcome adversity; therefore be  
14 it

15 RESOLVED, That the Senate designate the day before  
16 Thanksgiving, the Sunday after Christmas and New Year's Day, at  
17 6 p.m., a time to ring bells throughout this Commonwealth for  
18 five minutes as a sign of thanks, praise and unity.
