A RESOLUTION

1 Designating December 7, 2022, as "Pearl Harbor Remembrance Day"
2 in Pennsylvania.

3 WHEREAS, December 7, 2022, marks the 81st anniversary of the
4 Japanese attack on Pearl Harbor; and

5 WHEREAS, More than 3,500 military personnel and civilians
6 were killed or injured during the two-hour attack on Pearl
7 Harbor on December 7, 1941; and

8 WHEREAS, Nineteen ships were either destroyed or run aground
9 and more than 300 aircraft were destroyed or damaged as a result
10 of the attack; and

11 WHEREAS, There are 22 known servicemen from Pennsylvania who
12 lost their lives during the attack; therefore be it

13 RESOLVED, That the Senate designate December 7, 2022, as
14 "Pearl Harbor Remembrance Day" in Pennsylvania; and be it
15 further

16 RESOLVED, That the Senate recognize the outstanding bravery

1 of those who fought and the honorable sacrifice of those who
2 lost their lives or suffered injuries on that day.
