A RESOLUTION

Directing the Joint State Government Commission to conduct a 1 study to analyze and identify which environmental laws and 2 regulations of this Commonwealth have more stringent 3 standards than Federal law requires. 4 5 WHEREAS, Executive Order 1996-1, issued by the Governor on 6 February 6, 1996, provides that State agencies may not exceed 7 Federal standards unless justified by a "compelling and articulable" interest or required by State law; and 8 9 WHEREAS, Section 6.6 of the Air Pollution Control Act 10 provides that the Environmental Quality Board may only establish certain more stringent air quality standards when needed to 11 12 protect public health, welfare and the environment; and 13 WHEREAS, Because of the complexity and close interworking of 14 Federal and State environmental law, it is important that the 15 relationship between Federal and State environmental law and 16 regulation be examined and understood; therefore be it 17 RESOLVED, That the Joint State Government Commission conduct a study to analyze and identify which environmental laws and 18

recommendations to the General Assembly within one year 18
